Application requirements

- We are offering scholarship for both local and international students.
- Students applying for scholarship must be aged between 7 – 16 years old.
- Students must obtain minimum 70% grade in their last academic year.

How to Apply?

- Application forms are available online; students can download it from <http://pledgeharbor.org/admission/scholarship/> or collect it from PHIS admission office Saturday to Thursday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- All applications must be submitted by **30th November 2019** by email to admissions@pledgeharbor.org or sent to PHIS admission office.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview at admissions office
- Along with the application form, candidates must attach a copy of the last two years of academic reports and documentation.
- Lastly the senior management of PHIS will decide on the amount of scholarship.

How Long Do the Scholarships Last?

- Students who can maintain an average grade point of 5 or above may continue her/her education with scholarship at PHIS.
- Students failing to maintain grade point 5 will automatically be withdrawn from the scholarship.
- Students who graduate MYP programme with grade point 6 may apply for scholarship in IB Diploma Programme. The scholarship in IBDP may continue with the same conditions.

How Much Scholarship Support is Available?

- Up to **80%** on tuition fees.
- Students offered a scholarship will have to pay the admission fee and the security deposit.
